New Semester New Student Logins

Changing technology means changes in the way we use that technology. This new semester heralds a change in the way we log into computers on campus. Today we're going to go over how to log into all of the main systems.

- **Novell** – Login using your Career Account Username, a dot, the first letter of your username, a dot, and the word students. Ex: John Doe is jdoe.j.students
Your password has been reset to your 8 character birth date . You can find your Career Account Username in PC STAR.
- **Blackboard** – Login using your Career Account Username and current password. By default, this is your 6 character birth date. This password has NOT been reset.
- **Netmail** - Login using your Career Account Username and 8 character birth date. You have been assigned a new e-mail address. Your new email address will be your Career Account username @ calumet.purdue.edu.
- **PC STAR** – PUID login name and PIN will remain the same, no changes until Spring 2009.
- **OnePurdue Employee Self-Service** – Student Employees can access the OnePurdue portal to view their pay statements as well as other important employee contact information. Log in to the OnePurdue portal using your Career Account Username and your password.

There are kiosks set up to look up your Career Account username located in the SULB main concourse, the Powers computer lab, the Anderson lounge, enrollment services, the University Village, and the CLO lobby.
